A **Multidisciplinary Cancer Management Course in Prostate Cancer** will be held at CHU Treichville on November 18-20, 2019 with the goal of fostering inter-disciplinary communication and collaboration; improving knowledge on how to give multidisciplinary care through local case discussions; providing palliative and supportive care for patients with advanced disease. **The Workshop will be taught in English and French with translation.**

- Specialty-focused breakout sessions
- Patient communication skills
- Oncologic emergency case discussion
- Palliative care--conducting a pain assessment and end-of-life care


Dr. Serigne M. Gueye, Professor of Urology at Cheikh Anta Diop University of Dakar. Expertise in urology and surgical oncology.
